Dear Ms. Maltby:

This is to confirm the final planning fund distribution for State Fiscal Year 2027 is \$207,389 which includes Federal, State, and local match in support of the Calvert–St. Mary’s Metropolitan Planning Organization (C-SMMPO) Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). Of this amount \$121,970 will be Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Planning funds, \$43,941 will be Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5303 funds, and \$20,739 will be Special funds from the Maryland Department of Transportation’s Transportation Trust Fund. It is understood that the MPO will provide \$20,739 in local match funds. Please continue to document in your UPWP how the MPO is fulfilling the requirement to devote at least 2.5% of FHWA planning funding to Complete Streets activities for travel on foot, by bike, in a vehicle or using public transit. This consolidated planning funding is being provided subject to the Federal provisions.
