

A RESOLUTION BY THE CALVERT-ST. MARY'S METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING REVISED STATE STANDARDS DATA SHARING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Calvert - St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization ("C-SMMPO") was established to conduct regional transportation planning for the Calvert - St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning area in accordance with all applicable State and federal requirements;

WHEREAS, The C-SMMPO has obligations pursuant to applicable provisions of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act, 23 U.S.C. §134, ("FAST Act") to develop and carryout a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process for the C-SMMPO;

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA") and the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") issued a joint final rule on planning (Statewide and Nonmetropolitan Transportation Planning; Metropolitan Transportation Planning) requiring MPOs, state departments of transportation, and providers of public transportation to adopt an agreement to utilize a performance-based approach to planning to cooperatively determine their mutual responsibilities in carrying out the metropolitan planning process;

WHEREAS, the process of establishing performance measures and setting targets relies on cooperation and sharing of data and methodologies to effectively apply the performance-based approach to planning and programming mandated by law and regulations; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed and recommended adoption and approval of a draft Letter Agreement with the Maryland Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the draft Letter Agreement and the recommendations of staff, the C-SMMPO Council finds it is the best interest of the C-SMMPO to adopt the Letter Agreement as presented and attached hereto, hereby incorporated by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the hereby C-SMMPO hereby approves and adopts this Resolution with the revised state standards data sharing agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.
