RE: APPROVAL OF C-SMMPO FY 2025-2028 TIP ADMINISTRATIVE MODIFICATION FOR  
S-2018-13 AND C-2018-11

Dear Mr. Paul J. Wiedefeld,

The C-SMMPO approves the administrative modifications to the transit projects in the Calvert – St. Mary’s Metropolitan Planning Organization’s FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as revised.

The first modification is to the Rural Urban Transit Systems – St. Mary’s County Transit (S-2018-13), to modify 5311 funding. This will increase federal funding by \$163,512, local by \$166,990, and decrease state by \$3,478. Funding type 5307 will also be modified by increasing the local funding by \$5,004, decreasing state funding by \$5,004, and federal funding will remain the same. The total project cost is \$6,349,656. This is to provide operating assistance for the transit services provided by St. Mary’s County.

The second modification is to the Rural Urban Transit Systems – Calvert County Transit (C-2018-11), to modify 5311 funding. This will increase federal funding by \$129,933, local by \$132,574, and decrease state by \$2,641. Funding type 5307 will also be modified by increasing the local funding by \$702, decreasing state funding by \$702, and federal funding will remain the same. The total project cost is \$2,915,858. This is to provide operating assistance for the transit services provided by Calvert County.

The information provided regarding the changes proposed is in order and necessary by MDOT and is subsequently endorsed by the C-SMMPO. The proposed changes will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the TIP, which continue to be fiscally constrained.
